Delaware Soil & Water Conservation District



This spring and summer's heavy rains may have had an adverse impact on fish populations on local ponds. Water flowing through overflow pipes or emergency spillways could have washed the small fish out of your pond. The Delaware Soil & Water Conservation District's annual fish sale is a great place to purchase fish for restocking! More information on the fish species and stocking rates can be found in the Ohio Pond Management Handbook by the ODNR Division of Wildlife.

Orders are due by Friday, September 29, 2017 and you can pick up your fish on Thursday, October 5, 2017 at the Delaware SWCD parking lot from 12:30 to 1:30 p.m. Please bring sturdy containers filled with pond water for taking your fish home such as a five gallon bucket or trash can with a heavy duty plastic liner half filled with water. Triploid white amurs require a couple of gallons of water per fish. We recommend releasing your fish into your pond as soon as possible. If you have any questions call the office at 740-368-1921.
